BIODATA OF FACILITATORS

Ann House



Ann House, Ph.D., is a Research Social Scientist at the Center for Technology in Learning at SRI International, conducting education research and evaluation projects using mixed methods of investigation. At SRI, Ann's projects include programs and schools designed to promote deeper Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) learning, and global professional development programs promoting 21st century teaching and learning. She serves as core staff on an National Science Foundation-funded study investigating the external partnerships supporting and improving science lessons in afterschool programs, as well as a project that uses rubrics to examine the level of cognitive challenge in STEM-focused high schools. In 2006, Ann had the opportunity to visit schools in Singapore to study the impact of tablet computers on teaching and learning. She holds a master's degree in communication studies from University California at Santa Barbara, and a Ph.D. in speech communication from the University of Texas at Austin. Prior to joining SRI, Ann was a professor of Speech Communication at an urban university in Chicago, IL, USA.

Prior to joining Crescent Girls' School as the ICT Director for Staff Development, Richard was the Subject Head for English Language at the School of Science and Technology, Singapore. He then went to serve as an Educational Technology Officer in the Ministry of Education where he was involved in the development of the Baseline ICT Standards. He has presented at the RELC seminar, Redesigning Pedagogy Conference, MOE Excel Fest and iCTLT, and was awarded the prestigious MOE Service Excellence Award (MSEA) in 2007.
