Introduction

As Microsoft provides schools with tools that enable effective teaching within their respective fields, it is key that we share on how these tools can be maximized. We will be conducting training sessions to share with participants the affordances of Microsoft Office 365 to facilitate self-directed learning and collaborative learning. Features of the software will be shared, along with applications in a teaching and learning context. The workshop will be a hands-on session in which participants interact with the technology and experience its use in facilitating teaching and learning.

Learning Anytime, Anywhere with Microsoft Office365 (Academic)

Microsoft Office 365 for education breaks down classroom walls and extends learning possibilities to every student, anytime, anywhere. Using Office 365, teachers can develop lesson plans offline to post on a class website. They can create and share a digital notebook to pass onto their students as a study guide, and they can record lessons in class or elsewhere.

- Hands-on-Learning -Collaborating with Office, Office Web Apps and SkyDrive
- Debrief/Share/Wrap up

Teachers can share recorded lessons on their class site and also with other educators, reaching and inspiring more students in new ways.

Competition for jobs among young people is particularly strong, yet teachers using Office 365 foster skills that students will use in the workplace, such as using Word and Excel, and collaborating on group projects with the latest communications and collaboration services: Exchange Online, SharePoint Online and Lync Online, and Office Web Apps.

Exchange Online

Cloud-based email, calendar and contacts with always-up-to-date protection from viruses and spam.

SharePoint Online

Cloud-based service for creating sites to connect colleagues, partners and customers.

Lync Online

Cloud-based instant messaging, presence, and online meeting experiences with PC-audio, video conferencing and screen sharing.
